1. Add four P1 and one of $C$.
2. Go back through the first P1 in the opposite direction.
3. Pull tight and then tie a knot.
4. Add two P1 then pass through the last P1.
5. Add one $L$, one $P 2$ and one $L$ then pass down through the bead below the one you just exited.
6. Add one $L$, and one P2 then pass up through the P2 added in step 5 . Tighten the work by pulling the tread towards the tail of your work rather than forward.
7. Add two P 2 and one C then pass down through the lower P 2 .
8. Add two P2 then pass up through the last P2 added.
9. Add one L, one P1 and one L. Repeat from step 5 alternating petal colors as you go.


Eventually you will run out of thread. After you finish a flower continue around the top part of the flower and back through the center bead of the leaf section. Catch a thread below and tie a half knot around it. Continue through a couple more beads then trim the thread off. Add a new thread to your needle.

Pass through a couple beads on the top side of the flower. Catch a thread below and tie a half knot. Pass through remaining petal then through the center leaf bead again. Go through the lower part of the end flower exiting where you left off. Trim off the tail of your new thread.
