


INSTRUCTIONS


- Note: Add all B with the faceted side faceup. On 3 yd of thread, add A, C, two B-Left, C; repeat, leaving a 5" tail. Tie a knot against the tail to form a ring. Weave through the first six beads.
- 2. Add C; pass through the second hole of the A exited at the beginning of this step. Add C; pass through the first hole of the same A, the first C added in this step, and the second hole of the same A.
- 3. Add C, two B-Left, C, A, C, two B-Left, C; pass through the second hole of the A exited at the beginning of this step and the first five beads added in this step.

Repeat Steps 2 and 3 twelve times.

- 4. Note: A shorter segment of the bracelet is shown for illustration clarity. a) Jump to the second hole of the last A added. b) Add four C; pass through the open hole of the next B. c) Add C, D, E, D, C, then pass through the open holes of the next two B; repeat twelve times along the edge of the band. Note: Pull the E outward, if needed, to help them nestle between the other beads. d) Add C, D, E, D, C; pass through the open hole of the end A. e) Repeat Steps 4b–d along the other edge of the band. Tie off both threads.
- 5. Use jump rings to attach the clasp to the loops of four C at each end (not shown).
